

2024 VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS, CHARGES AND PERSONAL ITEMS

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

The Leda Primary School Independent Public School Board has approved the following information regarding the Contribution, Charges and Personal Items schedule for 2024. One of the requirements of the School Education Act 1999 is for schools to outline by December all contributions and charges that parents will incur for each child's education in the following year.

The schedule is as follows:

- Voluntary Contributions
- Charges Extra Cost Optional Components
- Personal Items for personal use in the educational program
- Other Items (not directly part of the educational program)
- Additional Voluntary Requests

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

The Leda Primary Independent Public School Board has endorsed an amount of \$50.00 per student as a **Voluntary Contribution for 2024**. This equates to approximately \$1.25 per week. These funds enhance the teaching and learning opportunities for all students and supplement funding gained from other sources, including the State and Federal governments.

We understand that paying these contributions at the same time as having to pay for booklists may place financial strain on some families. Therefore, we are happy to offer flexible payments of \$12.50 per term per child. Please contact the Manager Corporate Services to tailor a suitable plan.

Parents are advised that if they are able to pay the School Contribution amount when completing the Personal Items Lists, Campion Education will forward the money to the school with a complete list of payment details.

PERSONAL USE ITEMS - Items for personal use in the education program

A list of stationery your child will require for personal use in 2024 will be distributed. We have negotiated competitive pricing for high quality materials through Campion Education.

OTHER ITEMS - OPTIONAL

These optional activities and items are provided, but are not required for the educational program.

CHARITABLE COLLECTIONS

Parents should be aware that some Charity Collections are organised throughout the school year. Funds raised are given directly to the charity concerned, eg Perth Children's Hospital.

CHARGES - EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

These charges / costs are associated with specific learning activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made at the time of the excursion or in school activity. A breakdown of estimated charges has been included in the table below.

Students will only incur a charge when they are involved in a particular activity – the amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charge possible for scheduled activities during 2024.

CHARGES - SPECIFIC PROGRAMS

These charges are specific learning activities available to <u>selected students</u>, but conditional on a payment being made. The cost of Instrumental Music depends on which instrument a student is offered and whether an instrument is hired or purchased. There are no charges for tuition. The total PEAC charges and contributions paid per student will depend on the number and type of courses chosen by that student.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

The School and School Board strongly encourage all students from Kindergarten to Year 6 to wear the correct school uniform. Uniforms are available from Lowes, 1 Council Avenue, Rockingham.
